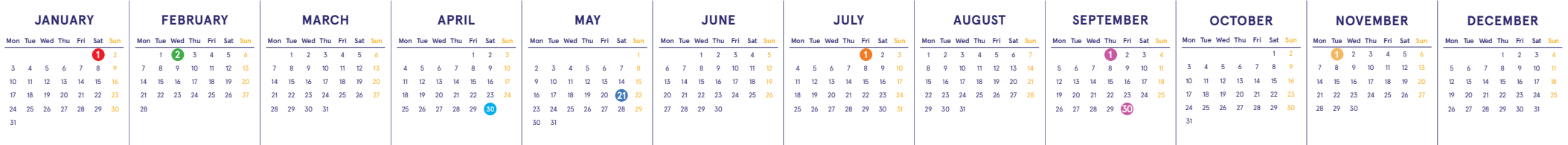




2022 TIMELINE



- JANUARY (1.1.22)**
- Full Import Custom Controls will be introduced.
 - GVMS (Goods Vehicle Movement System) to be used for imports/exports.
 - Pre-notification will be required for:
 - POAO (products of animal origin)
 - ABP (animal by-products)
 - All regulated plants and plant products.

- FEBRUARY (2.2.22)**
- Hauliers that operate loaded goods journeys in and between European Member States, may need to share information digitally about their journeys in the EU.

- APRIL (30.4.22)**
- Temporary extension to Cabotage ends in the UK.

- MAY (21.5.22)**
- Operators of goods vehicles over 2.5 tonnes and up to 3.5 tonnes in weight, that travel to the EU on journeys for hire and reward, will need to hold a Standard International Operator's Licence. Further requirements can be found on the Gov.uk website.

- JULY (1.7.22)**
- ENS Safety & Security declarations will be required for imports from EU to GB.
 - From 1 July certification and physical and identity checks will be introduced for:
 - All remaining regulated animal by-products
 - All regulated plants and plant products
 - All meat and meat products
 - All remaining high-risk food not of animal origin.
 - High-priority plants and plant products checks will transfer from place of destination to designated BCP's and Control Points from **1 July 2022**.
 - Most POAO and ABP imports from the EU to GB must have an EHC (Export Health Certificate).
 - Physical checks of POAO, certain ABP's, germinal products and HRFNAO (High-risk food and feed not of animal origin) will be introduced at designated BCPS.
 - Live animal checks will also transfer incrementally from point of destination to designated border control posts from **1 July 2022** as facilities are ready and designated.

- SEPTEMBER (1.9.22 / 30.9.22)**
- **1 September** – Certification and physical checks will be introduced for all dairy products.
 - **30 September** – Import declarations close on CHIEF and CDS to be used.

- NOVEMBER (1.11.22)**
- **1 November** – Certification and physical checks will be introduced for all remaining regulated products of animal origin, including composite products and fish products.
